## PUBLIC EXPRESSION

George Craft – 89 years old, Cameron Ave. – talked about the project that was started on his street, sidewalks and trees. I've talked to you Dean, you said that was what the Councilman had to do, to get this project going. Am I correct? To finish the project?

Chairman/President Button – My understanding is that we need lighting on that street, is that correct?

George Craft – Lighting and trees. I had (2) two beautiful trees, gone. How can the CIB get it done?

Chairman/President Button – So, if it's street lighting, that is a Councilman's decision. That does not come through this board.

George Craft – Excuse me, the Councilman is in a fight with the Mayor, you know that and I know it. What can we do to think out of the box and get it done? Dean, it's in your hands.

Chairman/President Button - Ok.

George Craft – Not the Councilman. Can you help me?

Chairman/President Button - I'll do the best I can. This board was formed to do a certain portion of the work. So, we have streets, roadways....

George Craft - Capital Improvement, if that isn't capital improvement, I don't know what is.

Chairman/President Button – No, but the district Councilmen were still provided a fund of money for which to fund....

George Craft – He doesn't have the money, you know it. All the money was to be put in (1) one pot and divided out. Am I correct?

Chairman/President Button – Not all the money, there was money that was distributed to each of the Councilmen, not as much as there had been in the past. Last year was about \$400,000. There is a formula that is determined on how much money this board gets to fund capital improvement projects. But lighting was not put in our responsibility to complete.

George Craft – Think out of the box. We don't want lighting; we want money to beautify this street. Which would be lighting.

Chairman/President Button - Ok.

Commissioner Prieto – What hundred block of Cameron?

George Craft - I'm in 3900, 4000, 3800, it's all....

Commissioner Prieto – Were any of those blocks, did any of those blocks get any lighting?
